93 people attended the forum and 3 topics were covered namely:

- Devolution of powers
- Form of government
- Land and property

**DEVOLUTION OF POWER**

1. The second majority voted presidential candidate to be the vice president of the country.
2. President should not be the commandant in chief of the armed forces.
3. The mayor and the governors should have powers

**FORM OF GOVERNMENT**

1. Youth and disabled should be involved in decision making on government issues.
2. The new formed districts to remain as they are and represent county.
3. Every district should have its own director
4.  $\frac{3}{4}$  of total revenue to remain in the collection region for its own development and while  $\frac{1}{4}$  to be taken to central government for relocation.

**LAND AND PROPERTY**

1. A lease be reduced to 25 years
2. There should be proper description and procedures of leasing and should be vetted by a committee from within the exercised area.
3. The Government/owner and investor should be strategically to allocate percentages of profit from any activity exercise of business involving displacement of person from his or her original land as follows:
  - Investor – 40%
  - Owner – 25%
  - Government – 35%
