CHAPTER 13 KADHIS COURT

209 (1) the powers of the chief Kadhi to be determined by the Muslims themselves but not parliament.

209 (3) all Muslims in the country should be given the opportunity to elect their Kadhis through voting

209 (4) the Kadhis court must have jurisdiction in the whole country but not the former protectorate

209 (6) the Kadhis court should act according to the Muslim religion teaches.

CHAPTER 14 DEVOLVED GOVERNMENT

The governor should have the powers to plan and use the available resources in his/her county.

A governor to be elected by the people from the area he/she is representing.
