**CHAPTER 14**

All towns should have their mayors as it has been and if possible they should be elected by the people.

**BILL OF RIGHTS**

The government should offer support to workers for their rights to be exercised and it should fight for their salary increase.

**TERMS OF SERVICE IN THE LEADERSHIP SYSTEM**

All the presidential, parliamentary and councils should serve for two terms only

**SECTION 42**

Part 3 of this section should be emitted or amended.

**SECTION 20**

The act on children found in Kenya and are below 8 years should not be considered as Kenyans if their nationality is not known.

The president should submit the monthly report to the citizens directly.

**SECTION 168**
