Bill of rights-chapter 6

- Bill of food should be made mandatory for the government to be always able to provide food to Kenyans
- The bill of medical and treatment should be included
- The constitution should state exactly age bracket of youth.

Land and property-chapter 7

Public land

- Land with minerals and minerals and is owned by a person should be given a right to decide on how the minerals to be extracted and be given 25% of total cost.
- The committee of experts should elaborate clearly about –the public land between the high and low water mark 79(1)k

Community land

- Parliament should not given powers to fully enact legislation to give effect to community land
- Land which has given out to foreigners instead of indigenous should be returned to indigenous and given valid title deeds.

Private land

- Land should be leased for between 22-25 years instead of 99 years

The executive-chapter 12

- The president and prime minister should all voted by citizens
- President and prime minister should collaborate to form commission of employing and firing judges.
- The president should alliance with the parliament to appoint or select commissions of inquiries.
- The president should be able to be taken to court like any other Kenyan.
- When the president has gone beyond the constitution and investigated by investigators from foreign countries and found guilty should be prosecuted since is the unifying factor.
- Dismissal of ministers and deputy ministers should be through votes of parliament by simply majority.

Judiciary-chapter 13

Kadhis courts

- Kadhis court should be in Kenya not within the former protectorate.

- Muslims should vote for the chief kadhi

Devolved government-chapter 14

- The county governments should be able to elect their leaders and directors of institutions available in their county's
- The county governments should forward 20% of its revenue to central government
