## **SUMMARY OF CONSTITUENCY BASED CONSULTATIONS AND PEOPLES VERDICT ON THE PERFORMANCE OF MEMBERS OF PARLIAMENT IN 2008 AND THEIR PETITION TO THE HONOURABLE MEMBER OF PARLIAMENT FOR 2009 AND BEYOND.**

### **LIKONI CONSTITUENCY**

#### **Review of Constituency perspectives on the performance of Member of Parliament:**

1. The MP has been quiet on the issue of taxation and grand corruption in Parliament.
2. The Land question has not been addressed.
3. The MP promised every youth will get employment opportunities. Todate, only 35 youths got casual employment.
4. Only the campaigners and those close to the MP were appointment to CDF committee.
5. No meeting has been held to consult the electorates since election
6. Women promised positions of leadership and funding for their projects, todate none has been funded
7. Youth were promised involvement in the management of projects, this has not been achieved.
8. It is difficult to access the M.P in the constituency
9. Access to funding is only possible to specific groups and people of specific ethnic communities while those others who voted for the MP do not access services from CDF.
10. The MP has not been participating in the parliamentary business, no motion or agenda has been presented for discussion since election.
11. Water issues have not been addressed especially in Mtongwe area.
12. The CDF hall is only made available to known people of political/ethnic affiliation.

### **Preparation of petition and priorities for Presentation to Member of Parliament:**

1. The land and historical injustices in Likoni constituency should be the MPs priority this year.
2. The MP should convene regular and publicized constituency based consultative meetings.
3. MP should work hard to ensure Kilindini County Council if established to provide jobs and bring municipal services closer to the Likoni constituents.
4. Youths from Likoni should be considered for jobs in the Port and Kenya Ferry Services.
5. The MP should prioritize water and sanitation and ensure the company is formed with women from Likoni considered for board membership
6. The MP should in partnership with the Municipal Council revive and equip the Likoni Fire Sub-station to avert fire disasters in the constituency and the South Coast.
7. CDF committee should be accountable and accessible to all.
8. The Bursary fund should be distributed fairly irrespective of ethnic background and party affiliation.
9. All Projects initiated by former MP made for community development should be completed before new ones are started.
10. Their M.P should lobby for a new constitution within parliament the way he promised during election.
11. The CDF hall should be allowed to be used by all community members irrespective of party and political affiliations.
