DEVOLVED GOVERNMENT

Local government should continue as it is.

25% of the area revenue (resources) should be sent to the central government while 75% remains in the production region.

EXECUTIVE

Vote of no confidence on the president/prime minister should be decided by the citizens.

Powers between prime minister and president should be shared equally.

Prime minister should be voted by wananchi.

KADHIS COURT

MPS should not be allowed to appoint Kadhis.

Madrasa should be supported by the government.

Women should be considered for jobs in the Kadhis court

Kadhis court should be at divisional level instead of district level

LAND AND PROPERTY

Every Kenyan should own land.

Incase someone's land has mineral resources, the owner should become a shareholder of the resources

Tenure of leasing should be reduced from 99 years to 20 years.
